Damodar Valley Corporation (DVC) has once again put forward their steps towards development of nearby villages surrounding its Mejia Thermal Power Station (MTPS) located in Bankura District of West Bengal by completing a LED street lighting project.

Sri Saumitra Khan, MP, Bishnupur and Sri Andrew WK Langstieh, Chairman, DVC had inaugurated the project on 16 February, 2016 at Durlavpur in presence of local public representatives and others. This LED street lighting covers a distance of 3.2 kms in Durlavpur–Raniganj stretch by erecting 55 LED street light poles at an expenditure of Rs.20 lakhs. LED bulbs reduces carbon footprint, saves energy consumption, contains no toxic material and are 100% recyclable. Sri Khan during the inaugural function highly appreciated the initiatives taken by DVC in this regard.
