Corporate Social Responsibility

Background:

DVC has always been driven by socially responsible values. In 1981, the Corporate Social Responsibility (the then Social Integration Programme-SIP) programme was launched and today it covers 629 villages within 10 km radius of respective projects in West Bengal and Jharkhand. Corporate Social Responsibility has touched and transformed life in the valley. Sustainable livelihood has been created through effective socio-economic measures. Soil conservation has been achieved. Health and family welfare have seen marked improvements. The local youths have become self-reliant with technical training. Self-help Groups help women pick up skills like sewing and knitting. Regular health related programmes have raised awareness levels and addresses a number of health issues. Basic education is ensured for the children of the valley through schools run by DVC. Poultry farming, pisciculture and food processing have generated livelihoods. In short, Corporate Social Responsibility has generated happiness and empowered the people of Damodar Valley. Damodar Valley Corporation has been doing CSR activities in the villages situated within 10 km radius of its major plant since 1981-82 on a continuous basis to ensure economic upliftment of the downtrodden and marginalized section of the society, specially the tribals and economically backward people. DVC's developmental initiative for its neighbour is one of the oldest CSR blueprint in India. The CSR programme has originated from an enabling provision in the DVC Act (1948) which provides for promotion of public health and agriculture, industrial, economic and general well-being in the valley and the area of operation of the Corporation. DVC is committed to the goal of sustainable development and conservation of natural resources. DVC strictly follows the principle of avoidance, minimization and mitigation in dealing with social issues and environment. Corporate Social Responsibility at DVC is its commitment to its stakeholders to conduct business in an economically, socially and environmentally sustainable manner that is transparent and ethical. Stakeholders include persons directly impacted by DVC's activities, local communities and society at large. As per Section 12(f) of DVC Act, 1948 the function of the Corporation has been started as "The promotion of public health and the agricultural, industrial, economic and general well- being in the Damodar Valley and its area of operation". Accordingly, DVC, since its inception contributes to sustainable development by delivering economic, social and environmental benefit to all stakeholders.

Policy on CSR: •

DVC came out with its CSR policy in 2011 and in pursuance to bring about a positive change, priority is accorded for undertaking activities for socio-economic development of the society living in the periphery of DVC's major plants. Adhering to the Department of Public Enterprise (DPE) guideline and United Nation's Millennium Development Goals, the following thrust areas have been rounded up as the CSR activities of DVC.

Salient features:

- The Corporate Social Responsibility aims at facilitating all round growth of DVC by enhancing the quality of lives of communities residing therein.
- Uplifting the socio-economic conditions of the communities residing around major projects of DVC.
- Supplementing but not substituting the socio-economic development programmes of the Government of India and respective State Governments for development in villages in CSR defined areas.
- Ensuring people's participation inter alia organizing and motivating communities into forming women Self-help Groups (SHG) through the process of social mobilization, training and capacity building at every stage of the programme from planning to implementation.
- DVC shall strive to improve the standard of living of the PAPs and community living in the target village through integrated development approach under its CSR and shall maintain a cordial relation with the local authorities and communities through transparency and continued development activities.
- DVC shall aim at minimizing social risk associated with the projects through the CSR programme.

Soil Conservation, Pisciculture and Environment Department

During FY 2021-22, DVC continued its activities in the field of Soil & Water Conservation in "Damodar-Barakar" catchment with its commitment for rain water conservation along with Soil Conservation through its time tested approach and more than seven decades of experience coupled with available resources. Restoration, Renovation and Repair of old Rain Water Harvesting Structures have been the centre of our focus of Soil and Water Conservation programme. DVC's continuous endeavour towards development of New Water Resources continued in the Catchment Area as this is the only long term solution for Socio-Economic development of the area. Pisciculture and its allied activities are also carried out by this department in the major reservoirs of DVC through its Aquatic Resource wing at Maithon and this activity is contributing in a big way towards livelihood generation for the local displaced people. During the FY 2021-22 the activities under taken have been mentioned below :

- 1. Restoration, Renovation and Repair of old water bodies in respect of soil & water conservation in six district of Jharkhand and one district of West Bengal to revive the life of the structures which have outlived their useful lives or their storage capacity has been minimised to a great extent.
- 2. Construction of new rain water harvesting structures in the catchment area with a view to create new water resources enhancing the availability of water for multipurpose such as micro irrigation and thereby bring more area under cultivation as well as multiple cropping system, domestic use along with augmentation of ground water recharge in the catchment area & prevention of soil erosion. Sometimes these structures are supplemented by construction of smaller bunds to prevent Soil erosion from the upper catchment.
- 3. Restocking of degraded Forest area in the catchment area of Konar & Tilaiya.
- 4. Enriching existing aquatic Resource in and around different projects of DVC as well as in the surrounding CSR villages through Spawn production, releasing of fingerlings, and maintenance of hatcheries at Maithon as CSR activities.
- 5. Soil Testing & fertilizer recommendation and issue of soil health card to the farmers of the catchment area as advisory services has helped the local farmers to take corrective measures to maintain the soil fertility.
- 6. Hydrologic and sediment monitoring system continued with data collection on smaller streams to find out quantum of soil losses as well as rate of reduction in runoff from the catchment area.
- 7. Preservation of Natural Resources at Tilaiya and Konar area including maintenance of deer park at Maithon and CTPS under biodiversity activities of the Corporation.

Pisciculture

In Valley area DVC having combined water spread area of 34447 hectares at full storage level and total productive water area of about 20116 ha. Damodar Valley Corporation has four major reservoirs Maithon, Panchet, Tilaiya and Konar. From the year 2007-08, work on development of reservoir fishery has rejuvenated and expanded in vigour way by involving local people under Primary Fishermen Co-operative Societies (PFCS) and Self Help Groups (SHGs). In the reservoirs, presently there are 35 registered Fishermen co-operative societies operating with a total of 1335 members.

Hatchery Management at Maithon Fish Farm:

Nearly 700 lakh Spawn have been hatched in the year 2021-22 and the same has been stocked in Maithon ponds as well as other small water bodies at Hazaribag.

One IMC Hatchery has been set up at Maithon Fish farm with a capacity of 20 million spawn production per operation, in order to supplement fish stock in different reservoirs. Excess spawn are being distributed to the members of the Fishermen Co-operatives, SHGs and progressive fish farmers for rearing in their own/ leased water body after meeting the demand of fish farm.

Stocking of fingerlings in DVC Reservoirs:

Like previous year Stocking of Fingerlings in all the reservoirs (Maithon, Panchet, Tilaiya & Konar) of DVC has been carried out with the help of State Fishery Department. Stocking of small check dams have been carried out and the balance fingerlings distributed among the marginal fish farmers for carrying out scientific Pisciculture in their own water bodies this year. Total fingerling produced 40 lakhs in 2021-22 and has been released in DVC reservoir & other water bodies.

Spawn distribution programme under CSR activity. Total 1201 no beneficiaries/ fisher Cooperative members benefited in 2021-22 under this programme, covering nearly 85 villages in & around DVC project area.
