Sub: Action Taken Replies/comments of DPE on the recommendations made by the of Department related Parliamentary Standing Committee (DRPSC) on Industry in its 307th Report on the subject "Impact of Covid-19 on the PSUs and the initiatives taken by the PSUs Under "Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan" - regarding

Sir,

I am directed to state that Department-related Parliamentary Standing Committee on Industry had submitted its 307th Report containing its views/observations recommendations. It has made the following recommendation at Para no. 32 of the Report relating to procurement by Central Ministries and Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) from Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs).

"The Committee observes that under the Public Procurement Policy (PPP), the MSEs are promoted to improve their market accessibility and competitiveness through increased participation in Government procurements and encouraging development of linkages between MSEs and Public Sector Enterprises (PSEs). As per the mandate of the Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises MSEs, Order 2012, every Central Ministries/PSEs should set an annual target of minimum 25% procurement of goods & services from MSE Sector. Out of 25% annual procurement, a sub-target of 4% & 3% should be from MSEs owned by SC/ST and Women entrepreneurs, respectively. Keeping in view the extraordinary situation, the Committee is of the view that the Central Ministries and PSUs may procure more than the prescribed limits laid down under the PPP for MSEs Order 2012, so as to give further boost to the localised production."

2. In this regard, CPSEs are requested to take note of the above recommendation made by Committee.
