1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
3. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
4. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
5. Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other

than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

6. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY. 7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

8. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 30% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

9. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
- If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
- In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods

3. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

i) **PRICE BASIS:**

The Contract Price shall be FIRM & FIXED during the entire execution of the Contract and shall not be subject to any variation except on account of Statutory Variation on direct transaction between the Employer (DVC) & the Contractor.

Landed Price of Coal shall be payable to the Agency based on the methodology outlined in this **Volume-IV: Scope of Work, Technical Specification and Other Terms & Conditions**.

ii) **TAXES, LEVIES AND DUTIES shall be as below:**

(a) Except as otherwise specifically provided in the Contract, the Contractor shall bear and pay all taxes, duties, levies, cess, etc. and charges assessed on the Contractor, its Subcontractors or their employees by all municipal, state or national government authorities in connection with the Facilities in and outside of the country where the Site is located.

(b) All taxes, duties, levies, royalties, fees, cess, etc in respect of the works, supply and all other services to be done by the Contractor as per the specifications of Bidding Documents and also taxes, duties, cess & levies as may be applicable on the materials used for the works, supply shall be to the contractor's account & included in the Contract Price. **The Contract price (for GCV: 3550 Kcal/ Kg alongwith base parameters of domestic coal as specified in Annexure-B1 to Volume -IV of the Bid Document) shall be inclusive of Freight, GST, GST Compensation Cess & all other taxes, duties, levies, royalty, cess, fees etc. on FOR Basis.**

(c) However, if DVC pays any taxes, duties, levies, cess, etc directly to the concerned statutory authorities, the same will be deducted from contractor's bill.

iii) **MODE OF SUPPLY & DELIVERY PERIOD:**

Coal indigenously produced within India including commercial mines (shall also be termed domestic coal) of specifications mentioned herein given at **Annexure-B1 in Volume-IV: (Scope of Work, Technical Specification and Other Terms & Conditions) of Bid Document** on "FOR Destination" basis at DVC power stations for quantities given at **Annexure-B2 in Volume-IV: (Scope of Work, Technical Specification and Other Terms & Conditions) of Bid Document** through Indian Railways. The Agency is free to opt the transportation mode for sourcing coal from mines but ultimately coal shall be delivered to DVC stations through Indian Railways. The timely supply of domestic coal as per the delivery schedule is the essence of contract. The total quantity of domestic coal for each station shall be delivered to stations, as per the delivery schedule to be given to the Agency by DVC. Delivery schedule for each station shall be given subsequently to the Agencies after acceptance of LOA. Delivery schedule may be extended further at the sole discretion of DVC.

However, validity of contract shall be 06 months from the date of placement of order.

iv) **TRANSIT INSURANCE:**

As per clause no. 9 of General Conditions of Contract (GCC) & Debarment Policy of DVC.

v) **PAYMENT TERMS:**

- a) No advance payment will be made to the Agency. Payment will be made on rake-to-rake basis.
- b) **Initial payment** against the net adjusted received coal based on the coal analysis results at DVC Laboratory for 50% of the total landed cost to be paid to the Agency within 15 days from the receipt of invoice and Railway Receipt (RR).
- c) **Interim payment** of Balance 40% will be paid after receipt of CIMFR/ 3rd Party Sampling Agency analysis results subsequent of quantity and quality adjustment after monthly reconciliation.
- d) **Final payment** of 10% will be paid after final reconciliation.
- e) **Sampling charges** at unloading end will be shared equally (50% -50%) buyer and Seller. Rake-to-Rake sampling charges based on the quantity received will be deducted from the running bill.
- f) **Railway freight** will be reimbursed/payable as per actuals, limited to the quoted transportation/freight cost after quality & quantity adjustment in line with the clause No.14 in Volume-IV: (Scope of Work, Technical Specification and Other Terms & Conditions) of Bid Document on submission of invoice and Railway receipt (RR). However, payment to receipt quantity & applicable freight charges will be limited to RR weight & freight charge. Besides, variation in railway freight tariff, if any, shall be dealt for the purpose of payment/adjustments, in line with clause No.14 in Volume-IV: (Scope of Work, Technical Specification and Other Terms & Conditions) of Bid Document. The term "Railway freight", wherever used, shall imply Base Railway freight plus any surcharge(s) as levied by Railways.

vi) **SECURITY DEPOSIT-CUM-PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE:**

Within Fourteen (14) days from the date of issuance of Letter of Award (LOA)/ Work Order (WO)/Purchase Order (PO), the successful Bidder (s) shall furnish performance security for satisfactory execution of the order for an amount equivalent to 10% of the Letter of Award (LOA)/ Work Order (WO)/Purchase Order value in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, account payee demand draft, fixed deposit receipt from a commercial bank, bank guarantee issued/ confirmed from any of the commercial bank in India or online payment in an acceptable form, safeguarding DVC's interest in all respects.

In case of Performance Security in form of Bank Guarantee, the bidder may furnish an Unconditional Bank Guarantee as per GeM format from any Nationalised / Scheduled Bank and it should remain valid for a period of 60 (sixty) days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the contractor, including Defect Liability Period (DLP)/ warranty period, as applicable.

If the Contractor fails to submit the performance security within 30 days of the date of issuance of LOA/PO/Work Order, DVC without prejudice to any other rights or remedies it may possess under the Contract, may forfeit the bid security (wherever applicable) and shall short close the Contract and retender and in this re-tender such defaulting Bidder will not be allowed to participate.

Other terms & condition SECURITY DEPOSIT-CUM-PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE as notwithstanding in tender document shall be as per DVC's GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (GCC) and Debarment Policy of this Bidding Documents.

vii) **AGREEMENT CLAUSE:**

Contracts shall be executed as per format attached in Vol-V: Bid Forms & Procedures (BFP) after receipt and verification of the requisite performance security (wherever applicable). The said agreement will be duly signed by the authorised representative of DVC and authorised signatory of Supplier/Contractor/ Service Provider/Consultant.

Within 7 days from the date of issue of LOA/PO/Work Order, DVC will send the agreement to the Supplier/Contractor/ Service Provider/Consultant for signature, incorporating all agreements between the parties for execution.

The Supplier/Contractor/ Service Provider/Consultant should acknowledge and unconditionally accept, sign, date and return the agreement within 14 days from the date of issue of LOA/PO/Work Order. If both parties simultaneously sign the contract across the table, further acknowledgement from the supplier is not required.

Non- execution of Contract Agreement by the Supplier/Contractor/Service Provider within 30 days from the date of issue of LOA/PO/Work Order due to the fault of the Supplier/Contractor/

Service Provider, will constitute sufficient ground for forfeiture of its EMD (wherever applicable) and shall short close the Contract and retender and in this re-tender such defaulting Bidder will not be allowed to participate.

viii) **CONTRACT PERIOD:**

The Contract shall remain valid for 06(six) months from the date of issuance of contract.

ix) **L.D CLAUSE:**

As per General Terms & Conditions of GeM.

If the Seller/Service Provider fails to deliver any or all of the Goods/Services within the original/re-fixed delivery period(s) specified in the contract, the Buyer will be entitled to deduct/recover the Liquidated Damages for the delay, unless covered under Force Majeure conditions aforesaid, @ 0.5% of the contract value of delayed quantity per week or part of the week of delayed period as pre-estimated damages not exceeding 10% of the contract value of delayed quantity without any controversy/dispute of any sort whatsoever.

x) **RISK AND PURCHASE CLAUSE:**

As per the provision of Vol-II: ITB under **Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC** of Bid Document.

xi) **QUALITY INSPECTION & DETERMINATION:**

QUALITY DETERMINATION shall be guided as per clause No. (6) in Volume-IV: (Scope of Work, Technical Specification and Other Terms & Conditions) of Bid Document.

xiii) **PENALTY CLAUSE:**

The Agency shall exercise utmost precaution at the time of supplying of coal to DVC stations. Coal having specifications beyond specified range of the Technical Parameters as per **Annexure B-1** under Volume-IV: (Scope of Work, Technical Specification and Other Terms & Conditions) of Bid Document shall not be supplied. The Coal of specifications beyond the specified range of the Technical Parameters shall be liable for penalty. **DVC shall not be held responsible for any financial loss to the Agency in any circumstances. Agency shall not have the right to take back the already delivered material.**
